CLASS 1 - TRUE NURSERY (17 YEARS & OVER) Entry fee £16.00

Neither a horse nor a rider to have been placed 1, 2 or 3 in a competition with cross-country (including horse trials and hunter trials) Max height 2'3", distance approx 1.75 miles.

Moscrop Trophy to the winner.

CLASS 2 - OPEN NURSERY (17 YEARS & OVER) Entry fee £16.00

Max height 2'3", distance approx 1.75 miles.

CLASS 3 - JUNIOR NURSERY (UNDER 17 YEARS ON 2/10/05) Entry fee £16.00

A combination of horse and rider not to have won a competition with cross-country (including horse trials and hunter trials) Max height 2'3", distance approx 1.75 miles

CLASS 4 - JUNIOR OPEN (UNDER 17 YEARS ON 2/10/05) Entry fee £16.00

Max height 2'9" distance approx 2.3 miles.

CLASS 5 - NOVICE (17 YEARS & OVER) Entry fee £16.00

This class is a qualifier for the Finals of the SEIB BHS Cross Country Championships 2006. During the past 2 years, horses not to have won more than a total of £20 in competitions with cross-country (including horse trials and hunter trials) nor to have won first place in such a competition at

Novice standard or above. Max height 2'9", distance approx 2.3 miles.

Garnett Cup to the winner.

CLASS 6 - OPEN (16 YEARS & OVER) Entry fee £16.00

This class is a qualifier for the Finals of the SEIB BHS Cross Country Championships 2006.

Max height 3'3", distance approx 2.3 miles.

Burden Cup to the winner.

CLASS - OPEN PAIRS Entry fee £16.00

This class is a qualifier for the Finals of the SEIB BHS Cross Country Championships 2006.

Time, weather and ground permitting. Entries on the field.

Pots and Pans Shield to the winners.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries must be sent in writing to Mrs Lynn Anderson, Jubilee Cottage, Gavinton, Duns, Berwickshire TD11 3QT . Entries close Monday 26 September 2005. No entries accepted without remittance. No entry fees will be refunded after the closing date. Late entries (at £20.00 per entry) may be accepted at the discretion of the Entries Secretary. Please notify the Secretary of any withdrawals. In the event of cancellation 75% of the entry fee will be refunded.

The course will be open for inspection on Saturday 1 October 2005 from 2PM. Starting times will be available at the secretary's caravan or by contacting Lynn Anderson - tel 01361 883796 **between 6pm and 9.30pm on Friday 30 September 2005**

Crash hats (BSI 4472, BSI 6473, PAS015) and Body Protectors are compulsory. Any competitor jumping any fence other than the allotted practice fence, unless under starters orders will be disqualified. Eliminated riders must leave the course and return at a walk - on no account may they continue the course.

Horses must be 4 years old or over. No horse may compete more than once in any class.

The Organisers reserve the right to alter, cancel or divide any class, to and after the advertised time and to refuse entry without stating the reason.

The Organising Committee and Cayley Walton Partners will not accept any liability for any accident, injury, illness or damage to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

All classes will be judged on optimum times. The optimum times will be displayed on the secretary's caravan. To be judged under current BHS/MFHA Rules for the Hunter Trials with the exception of the horses height limit. The Judge's decision is final.

Refreshments will be available. All dogs must be kept on leads.

Location - The Hunter Trial will be sign-posted onto the Mordington road off the Berwick to Chirnside road, approximately one mile east of Foulden.

No competitor or horse may ride over the course one week prior to the Event.

This event is a qualifier for the Finals of the South Essex Insurance Brokers BHS Cross Country Championships 2006. In the nominated qualifying classes, the TWO highest placed riders (or two highest placed Pairs) who are BHS Gold Members ON THE DAY OF THE QUALIFIER will qualify for the Final. In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification will pass down to the next eligible competitor. You must provide the Entries Secretary with your BHS membership number when you enter the qualifier but we recommend you also carry your membership card on the day. Non-members may enter qualifying classes but will not be eligible to qualify. Horses registered for British Eventing Horse Trials in 2006 are NOT eligible to qualify for the Finals ('Day Tickets' are acceptable). Rules at qualifiers may differ from those at the Finals. Classes at the Finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max 2' 9"), and Open (max 3' 3"). Date (Autumn 2006) and venue for the Finals are to be confirmed.
